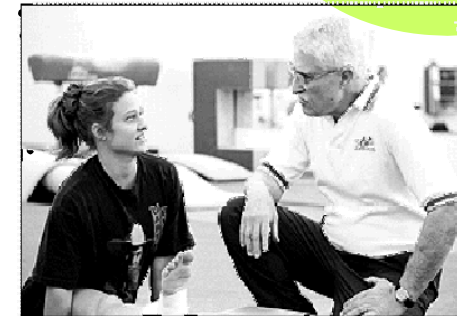

What is involved? Level 1 Course

Level 1 Gymnastics Coach Accreditation involves attendance at a two-part course that is offered over 2 days, plus the completion of the online : Beginner Coaching Course 100% attendance is required. Following completion of the course candidates have approximately three months to complete the Post-Course workbooks and submit them for assessment. Extensions maybe applied for by contacting the Development Officer at Gymnastics SA.

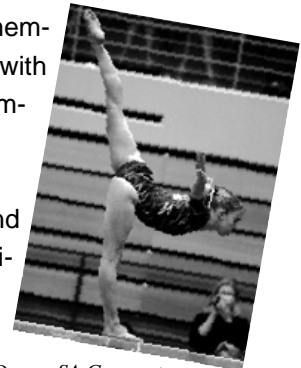
Being professionally qualified is great for your club's public relations and credibility.
